USE AND USAGE

Levels (A1), A2, B1 Clare Lavelle

The purpose of this course is to give students the chance to improve their knowledge in English: by revising their grammar, tidying up any misunderstandings or problems, acquiring new vocabulary, working on their reading skills and learning how to take notes while listening and practicing spelling and punctuation.

Grammar: A complete grammar review will be made and each revision point will be followed by a discussion and analysis to make sure students understand how English works, with lots of opportunities to speak to reinforce the use and usage of this.

Reading skills: Anticipation of content from context, skimming, scanning, dealing with unfamiliar words and making inferences. (Practice for TOEIC) Listening comprehension and note-taking will improve written and listening skills.

Student-led activity: An opportunity will be given for students to create an activity or a project to research and explore on their own and possibly present to the group. Various past projects have included: designing a course lesson, creating games, making a video...

Evaluation: 50% class work and participation 25% homework 25% student-led activity/project
