In the News Clare Lavelle - Levels B2-C1

What's in the news? From the serious to the light-hearted, and from the culture-specific to the universal, the news interests and intrigues readers everywhere.

This course will enable the students to become efficient and critical readers. Articles will be dissected and analyzed, discussed and debated. There will be ample opportunity for budding journalists to learn the characteristics and conventions of journalistic writing.

- Expanding vocabulary and working with idiomatic expressions.
- Practice discussing, debating, hypothesizing and interviewing.
- Writing short news reports and articles.
- Improving listening skills.
