Making Movies David WILSON

Levels B1-C1

Course content:

The objective of this course will be to introduce students to basic film-making techniques and to enhance their skills in both written and verbal communication.

Starting off with an original idea, students will learn how to develop a scenario and storyline before moving on to scriptwriting and final screenplay. Some iconographic examples of classic movie scenes will be reviewed.

By working together students will undertake a creative team project that will culminate in a short film production and probable acclaim...

Evaluation:

Students will be principally evaluated on their active participation and productivity throughout the sessions as well as during the final presentation and screening. Completed scripts will also form part of the assessment.

Recommended level:
