# Decoding "The Matrix"

Behind the veil of a science fiction blockbuster, *The Matrix* (1999) is one of the most seminal films of recent times. It uses elements of comparative mythology inspired by the work of anthropologist Joseph Campbell, considered the "Yoda" (mentor) of George Lucas. Through in-depth film analysis (image, sound, script) and tracing its sources of inspiration (Japanese, Hong Kong, American), this course aims to uncover layers of symbolism (Buddhist, Hindu, Gnostic, Marxist) in the film.
