English for GCC/Architecture students - Projects

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Learning goals

The aim of this course is to develop core competences - collaborative and communication skills (oral, written and visual) and project management skills.

Learning objectives

Exploring architecture, and communicating about it. We will look at different architectural themes that are chosen by the group. These could be to do with history, architectural design in different cultures, specific structures - bridges or amphitheatres, for example, as well as iconic architects.

Course expectations

This course is student-led and project-based. Everyone will have their group project, as well as an individual presentation to give, in order to debate a specific topic.

Evaluation is based on active participation (40%) (presence, involvement and collaboration), and a project (60%), team work and cooperation, Project management – fulfilling objectives, time management, quality of presentation and reflexivity (critical thinking skills).
