

# USE AND USAGE

Levels A2-B2

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The purpose of this course is to give students the chance to improve their knowledge in English: by revising their grammar, tidying up any misunderstandings or problems, acquiring new vocabulary, working on their reading skills and learning how to take notes while listening and practicing spelling and punctuation.

**Grammar:** A complete grammar review will be made and each revision point will be followed by a discussion and analysis to make sure students understand how English works, with lots of opportunities to speak to reinforce the use and usage of this.

**Reading skills:** Anticipation of content from context, skimming, scanning, dealing with unfamiliar words and making inferences. (Practice for TOEIC)  
Listening comprehension and note-taking will improve written and listening skills.

**Student-led activity:** An opportunity will be given for students to create an activity or a project to research and explore on their own and possibly present to the group. Various past projects have included: designing a course lesson, creating games, making a video, etc.

**Evaluation:**

- 50% (CA) class work and participation (quizzes/role plays, opinion and analysis, discussions and talks)
- 25% homework (weekly written work and preparation for Speakers' Corner)
- 25% student-led activity/project
