2	Mini Project of Investment Economics	361305	1	English	The subject provides students with practical skill on project analysis. Students are assigned to analyze an urban housing project, including financial end economic analysis activities.
3	Construction Project Management	360450	2	English	Providing professional knowledge on Construction Project Management (PM), and mainly focusing on the perspective of owners and PM consultancies. Including three chapters: Fundamentals on projects and PM; Project delivery systems and Construction contracts; and major PM processes.
